This year has been an exceptional challenge, through, which it seems, many of you have persevered, adapted, and overcome the many obstacles put in your way. I am not surprised, but I am impressed.

The LIFE Foundation has survived as well. "Thank you" doesn't even come close to the depth of appreciation we have for your support. It is because of your kindness and generosity that we have gathered donations equaling \$8,084.52. It is with great sadness that many of those donations came from the heartfelt loss of many great DKG women. However, on a happier note, donations were received honoring many friends, women who work hard to make this wonderful organization the powerful gift of support for all women educators. Our hearts are full of shared love.

Last year we gave 24 grants, totaling \$12,546. This year we were able to give 12 grants totaling \$7,837 this month. If worse comes to worse, and next year even if we were to have no income and few expenses, we will still be able to give about \$10,000 in grants to deserving teachers


