

How LIFE Can Support You?

Do you have an idea for a learning and literacy project for children in the state of California? Apply for a LIFE Grant. Here's how:

- Log into the LIFE website and find the Grant Application button. Insert the name of your project.
- Give your name and contact information.
- Provide a brief description of your project and how it impacts the learning and literacy of your target population.
- Give a detailed anticipated budget for your project. \$1,000 is the maximum grant for grants impacting less than 75 children. \$1,500 for more than 75.
- LIFE does not reimburse for fees for service, rentals, general supplies or continuing education.
 Applications are due March 1
- Membership in DKG is not required.

The LIFE Foundation has been providing grant funds for learning and literacy projects throughout California since 1999. Here are some ways LIFE has impacted children:

\$200 was awarded to a grant that provided new and gently used books for 45 to 55 young children of single parents who enrolled in a community college.

\$750 of LIFE funds helped purchase 800 copies of "The Wind and the Willows" which were distributed throughout one county as part of a Book in Common project.

\$1000 purchased fiction and nonfiction books about robots and robotics for 3 elementary schools, 1 middle school and 1 high school to support their GATE program.

\$1000 provided a first-grade classroom with leveled books with science and social science themes.

\$1000 purchased audio books with matching hardcover books for elementary school students.
